



Self- Guided Tour Points

- A. Courtyard Terrace Assisted Living facility
- B. World's Porch Swing in Roosevelt Park (5th St & Jefferson Ave.) - 32 feet long and can hold 24 children or 18 adults.
- C. Hebron Post Office Mural (5th St N. of Lincoln Ave.) -Painted by Miss Eldora Lorenzini in 1939 as part of the New Deal's Public Works of Art Project. One of 12 in Nebraska.
- D. Arrowhead Gardens Arboretum (south side of Jefferson Avenue)- established in the 1920's contains 11 varieties of trees and 6 different types of native grasses and many plants.
- E. Hebron CCC and POW Camps Monument-Located just off Jefferson Avenue (look for historical marker signs) just to the west of Riverside Park. The area hosted a Civil Conservation Camp during the Great Depression and German POW's during World War II
- F. Thayer County Courthouse (4th. Street north of Olive Avenue)-Built of Indiana Limestone in the Romanesque and Gothic style. Four carved faces are found on the outside and ask about the mystery related to the carvings.
